LCC Meeting Highlights from the Community Clerk

On January 16th, Ken Lake welcomed the new 2024 LCC board. During the virtual meeting, there was good attendance with over 30 members present.

The board discussed Donna Virgilio being previously removed from the board, and a motion was then made to reinstate her (with the intention that she could resign), due to the current board disagreeing with the validity of the previous boards' decision.

The Urban Forest Committee commented on the trail being littered with rice and beans, and is urging whoever is doing this to stop. It is harmful to the trail and the animals that feed on it.

Security Officer Ralph Oliver reported on some suspicious vehicles in December, and also some inconsiderate speeders in our neighborhood. Resident license plates have been recorded and Ralph suggested putting them in the newsletter again.

The treasurer Leslie stated that our finances are good, and balances are good, and voting on purchasing CD's needs to happen today.

Common Area Manager Caleb Spring reported on ordering signage, issues with turning off water with the city, and had questions about spending.

The ACC reported of the following approvals: a fence at 2095 Lakemoor, a shed at 1615 Camden Circle, a home addition at 1708 Camelot, a fence at 1720 Lakemoor, and a tree cutting notification at 2179 Lakemoor.

Al Hatten of the Lake/Stormwater Committee reported on an update with the City of Olympia. He stated that our community is responsible for the storm water issues in our neighborhood, not the city. He stressed the need for a charter and action plan to address this issue.

There were no reports from Events, Urban Forest, Long Range Parks Planning Committee, Goose Committee, or Gardens.

Our VIS Manager Anastasiya explained VIS's role to the new board members, including financial tracking, compliance, meeting support, and more.

The board then voted on their new officers, with the following results:

Urgent Message from the Urban Forest Committee



1. Around Christmas someone dumped raw rice near UF kiosk & big rocks and around Jan 1-4th a <u>huge amount of raw beans</u> (~10+lbs) were dumped to the right of the kiosk, closer to the drainage area – both sites are at the entry to the Urban Forest Common Area!!!

3. This is NOT GOOD. <u>It will attract RATS!!!</u> It molds and causes gastrointestinal problems for any animal that eats it (including dogs).

5. On Jan 24th MORE raw beans were put on the ground in piles and scattered along the first part of the trail -- extending to the Children's Forest.

7. This behavior needs to STOP. DO NOT FEED WILDLIFE ON LLC SHARED LANDS!!!

9. NOTE: If someone wants to attract wildlife <u>they should do it at their personal property.</u>

11. <u>Everyone</u> – keep your eyes out for such infractions & AND report the name of that person to the board.
