Notes from the April 22 LCC Board Meeting (official minutes are posted on website after board approval)

No minutes were approved, as the board did not have sufficient time to review them.

The Urban Forest committee reported on their recent meeting. They have stated that the homeless camp is not on our property, however it is very near our boundary, it is negatively affecting our neighborhood, it has the potential to grow, and it is beyond the scope of the UF Committee. The Committee transferred assessment, recommendations, and map documents to the board and the Committee is asking for the board's support. Diseased trees in the UF will be felled on 4/28, and the trail will be closed.

The Events committee reported on a fun and successful Egg Hunt and Fishing Derby. There is lots to look forward to as well, including the bike clinic, yard sale, summer social and dog days of summer. In addition, a new family yoga event was approved and the return of the in-person annual meeting.


The Architectural Control Committee reported the following approvals: a fence @ 1506 Lakemoor Loop, a ramp at 2099 Lakemoor, a second shed @ 1998 Lakemoor a portable canopy @ 1711 Camden Park Dr, a fence @ 2087 Lakemoor, and fence @ 2321 Lakemoor.

The Lake Treatment Committee reported on two bids that they received for our chemical treatment of the lake. The board voted to accept their recommendation of hiring NW Aquatic Management at an estimate of 14K per season, based on two treatments.

The Compliance Committee spoke about the changing demographics in the neighborhood, and a need for a review of the current rules and solicitation of public comment for the proposed changes. Stay tuned!

The Stormwater Committee recommended approving a contract with a project management company regarding stormwater treatment. The board approved retaining Herrera for our stormwater study contingent upon a more detailed proposal.

President Dani Clark proposed a date for a May meeting, which doesn't align with the usual 4th Monday. It will be Thursday May 30th. In addition, she started a flow chart to help organize items for consideration at the upcoming meetings. This will be a work in progress.

Our board has been busy, with two meetings in April, and one coming up at the end of May.
