Notes from the September 23rd LCC Board Meeting (official minutes are posted on website after board approval)

August minutes approved. Many community comments were read, all about the 2151 easement, including both in support and against proposal, request for community vote, and questions about clarity. After the board statement below, more comments were made by residents both in support and questions posed.

There was reading of a board clarifying statement regarding the 2151 plot.

- · The board is considering access only, with no time limit
- Full fees would be \$19,000 to \$24,000
- The current budget contains no increase to fees for this purpose, which would require a vote of the homeowners
- Use of a trail is permitted by covenants

Later in the meeting, the board decided to submit a community proposal to purchase an easement at 2151 which will occur between Oct. 1 and 21. The board will report the outcome, and the board will respect the outcome of the vote.

The board discussed working with the city to make the entrance to the front of the neighborhood safer and plan to collect stories to share with the city. Request for community members to pick up their own dog waste, and a reminder that all bins including regular garbage bins can be used for that.

The Common Area Managers Mike and Randy reviewed the dock at the west side, and determined that it is not substantially lower but some of the trex boards are starting to warp. They reported that the parks are in good shape, but some fine tuning is needed.

The ACC reported on tree removal notification at 2019 Clairmont Circle.

The Stormwater Committee reported that preparations are underway for the October 28th Town Hall meeting to discuss findings and options for stormwater systems improvement.

The events committee reported that the last Dog Days of Summer has a great turn out, and that the Fall Festival is on October 6th.

Treasurer Leslie Turner reported that the budget meeting will take place at the beginning of the October 22 planning meeting

The Goose Committee is currently monitoring 6 geese who visit at night. The committee is working hard to remedy this, and suggested owl statues or spinners on the floating docks. They will not use screamers between midnight and 4am.

The Urban Forest reported that a number of dead trees were cut by a volunteer resident who is a professional forester, but there are still large trees that need to be removed. Currently the committee is working with the Treasurer regarding budgetary needs.

The Long-Range Parks committee has been re-established, and is hoping to get a good mix of residents and board members.

The board decided to hire all five applicants of the garbage contractor job, and will work with the Common Area Managers to plan out the details.
